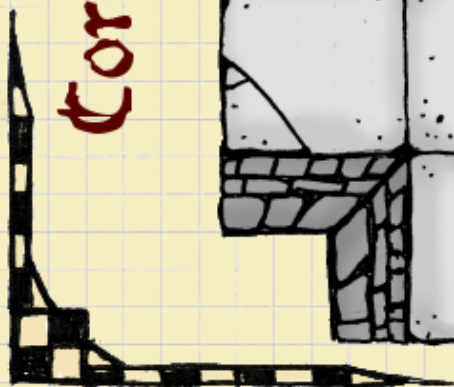


Corridors & Junctions

(5 ft wide)

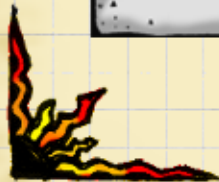

Doors

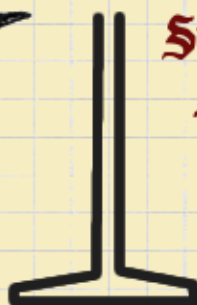
for 5 foot wide exits

"step"



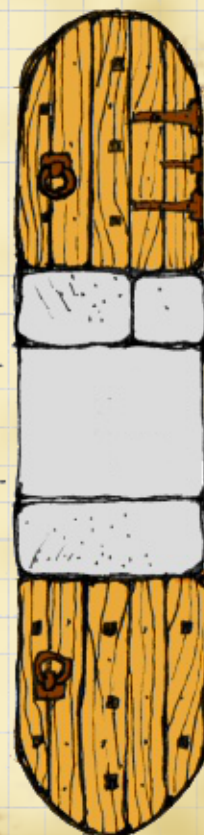
Standing Doors

Cut along the edges.
Then fold at the base and
"steps" then glue the
backs of the doors
together.

Strong card is
recommended but paper
still works well.

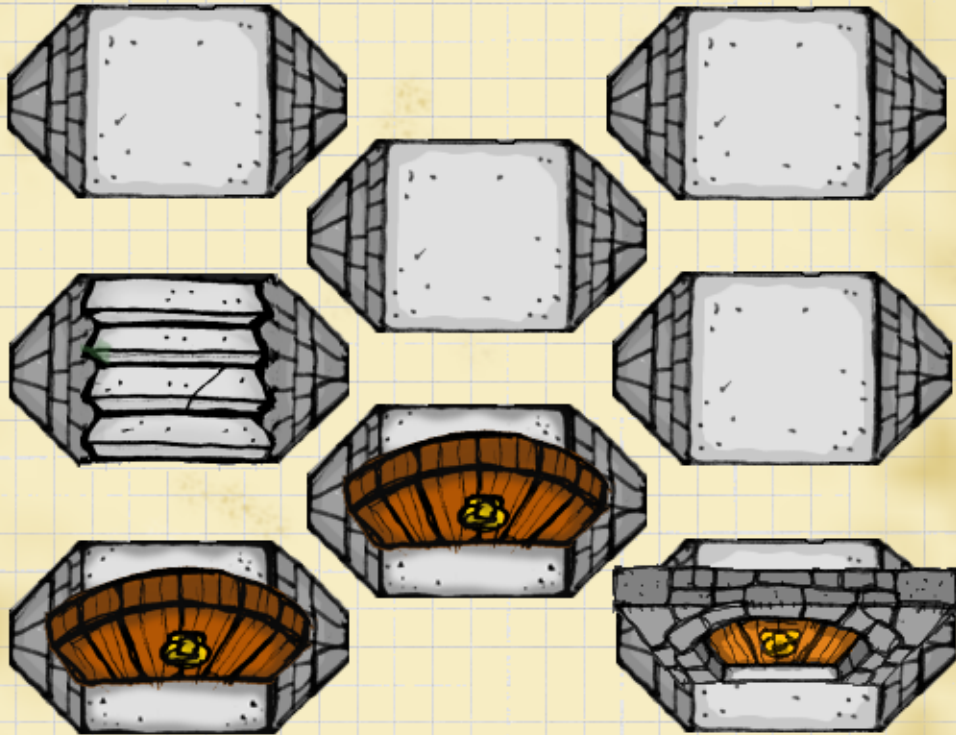
Taping a coin to the base
can prevent doors being
blown over during play.

Alternatively, the doors
can be modified to slot
into plastic figure bases.

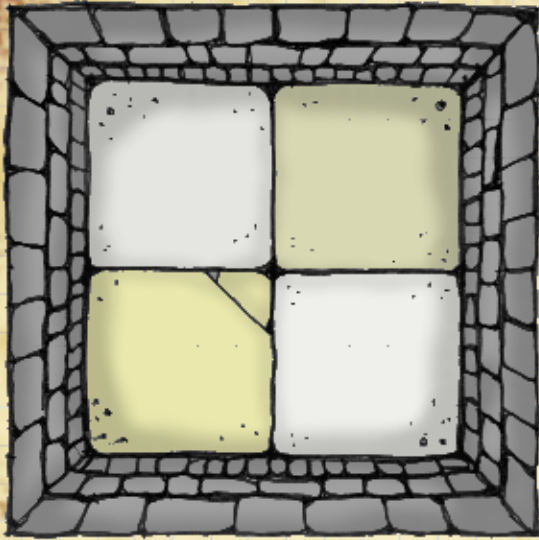

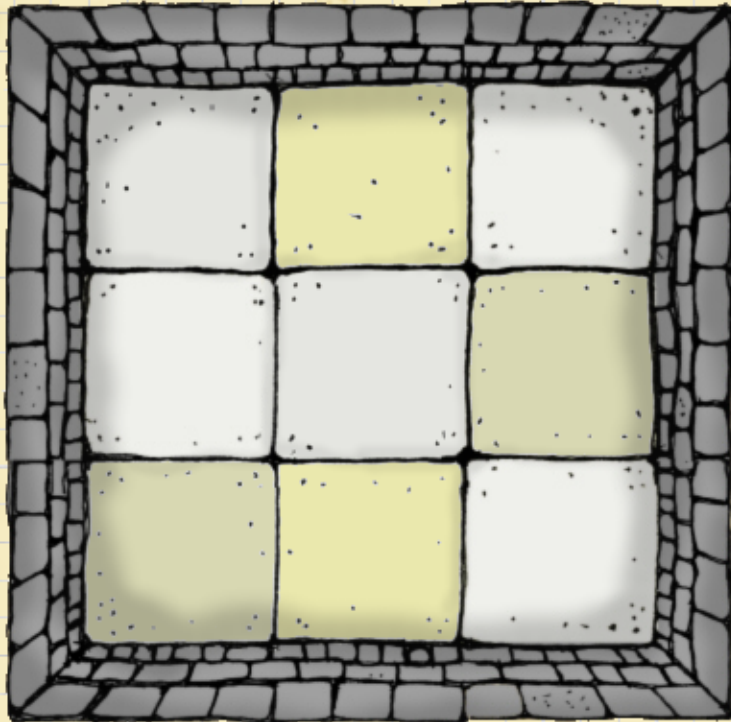

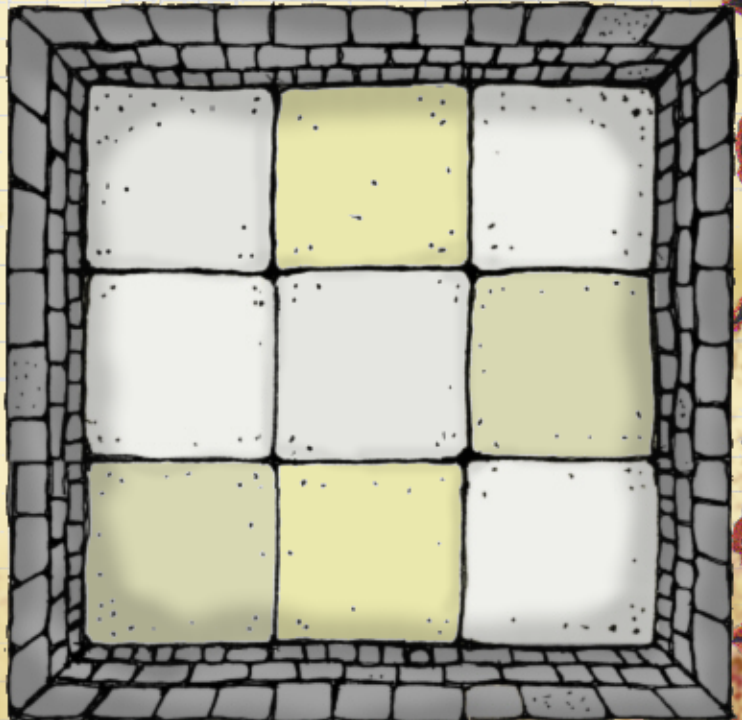
